

## **EXCEL AND THE POWER BI COURSE**

In March 2024, MILVEST made a strategic move to empower transitioning defence officers and personnel by introducing Excel and Power BI courses by faculty of IMI Bhubaneshwar, which were integral to its leadership development program. In today's data-driven business landscape, proficiency in these tools has become essential for effective decision-making and organizational success. The courses offered participants not only theoretical knowledge but also practical, hands-on training, allowing them to gain valuable experience in transforming raw data into actionable insights. This skill set is particularly critical for defence personnel aiming to excel in the corporate world, where data analytics drives informed business decisions.

The Excel and Power BI courses were carefully structured to cater to defence personnel with a wide range of familiarity with data analysis tools. Whether participants were new to these platforms or already had some background, the courses were designed to accommodate their varying levels of expertise. The learning path was gradual and well-paced, ensuring that participants could build a solid foundation before moving on to more advanced topics.

The Excel training began by focusing on core functionalities such as data entry, sorting, and filtering. As the participants progressed, they were introduced to more complex features like pivot tables, advanced formulas, and data visualization techniques. These advanced functions enabled them to manage large datasets efficiently, equipping them to perform tasks such as financial analysis, operational planning, and performance monitoring. A major emphasis was placed on Excel's ability to streamline workflows, automate repetitive tasks, and enhance overall productivity—skills that are indispensable in any business setting.

Similarly, the Power BI course introduced participants to the capabilities of business intelligence and dynamic reporting. They were trained on how to import, clean, and transform data from various sources, eventually learning how to create visually compelling dashboards. These dashboards provided a comprehensive view of business performance metrics, making it easier for participants to understand and communicate complex data insights to stakeholders. 

# FACILITY MANAGEMENT

The Management Essentials program by IIM Shillong, conducted by the Sambhav Kadam Foundation under the flagship initiative "Project Deepak," commenced its wonderful journey on 26 Jan 24. Enriched with a plethora of management modules, the entire program and its sessions have been exceedingly educative and engaging. Moreover, it regularly introduced new surprises and excitement, with the Mentor module on Facilities Management (FM) as part of corporate learning being a real treat.

"It was a real treat" is not a frivolous comment but a sincere statement. The value of the foundation course lies not in the negligible amount we paid but in its professional quality.

The FM module started on 15 Apr and concluded on 16 Jun, comprising two months, 14 hours, and 10 sessions. It covered a wide range of FM topics, encompassing multiple functions essential to ensuring smooth operation physical workplaces, of technology, and manpower. Their integration was critically required to maintain and improve the efficiency of work environments. The comprehensiveness of the course was reflected in the coverage of key areas, including workplace services, occupancy management, stakeholder management, procurement, vendor management, cost and budget control, health, safety, and environment (HSE), quality control, project management, and office management. Each topic was discussed in detail, and participants explored the skills required and their role in creating a successful FM strategy.



# KYC IN GLOBAL BANKING

MILVEST, in its commitment to providing cuttingedge learning opportunities, had conducted a specialised module on the Know Your Customer (KYC) function in a Global Investment banking context. The module was conducted by Mr. Karmveer Singh Gusain, a retired Army officer and currently a Team head in the KYC function, and offered deep info into the complexities of compliance, management, onboarding within the financial sector. The module was set over three one-hour sessions on Sundays— 5th, 12th, and 26th May 2024.

Mr. Gusain's transition from the armed forces to the financial services industry exemplifies adaptability and continuous learning. Leveraging his extensive experience in leadership and strategic operations, he has successfully navigated the complex domain of KYC, ensuring compliance with global regulations and risk management protocols at Credit Suisse. His background provides participants with a unique perspective, blending military discipline with the nuances of the banking sector.



Session 1: Introduction to KYC and Regulatory Landscape (5th May 2024). The opening session focused on the fundamentals of KYC. Mr. Gusain introduced the regulatory environment, emphasizing the importance of KYC in preventing money laundering and financial crime. Participants learned about global standards, such as the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) guidelines, and how these translate into practical procedures for banks. The session aimed to build a foundational understanding of why KYC is critical for maintaining trust and integrity in financial markets.

Session 2: Client Onboarding and Risk Assessment (12th May 2024). The second session delved into the client onboarding process, highlighting the steps involved in verifying a client's identity and assessing their risk profile. Mr. Gusain shared real-world examples from his experience, offering practical insights into the challenges faced during the onboarding process. Participants explored various risk indicators and how technology and automation are employed to streamline the KYC function, ensuring efficiency while maintaining regulatory compliance.

Session 3: Case Studies and Practical Application (26th May 2024). In the concluding session, Mr. Gusain led participants through detailed case studies to illustrate the application of KYC principles in reallife scenarios. He encouraged interactive discussions, allowing participants to critically analyse situations and propose solutions based on the knowledge gained in the earlier sessions. This hands-on approach ensured that attendees could connect theoretical knowledge with implementation, a crucial skill in today's fast-paced banking environment.

The KYC module, guided by Mr. Karmveer Singh Gusain, is a testament to MILVEST's commitment to providing relevant, practical learning experiences. By bringing experts from diverse backgrounds, MILVEST ensures that its participants gain well-rounded insights that prepare them for dynamic roles in the industry. As the financial sector continues to evolve, such training modules become indispensable for professionals aspiring to excel in compliance and risk management.

## DIGITAL DESIGNING ESSENTIALS

On a lazy Sunday morning, the MILVEST Subah–Savere-Sunday event electrifies the drowsy spirit, motivating me to dive into the thrilling sessions of "Digital Designing Essentials" and "LinkedIn Learning Essentials." Each Sunday offers a dynamic combo of two segments, ensuring an enriching experience.

The first session of the Digital Designing segment began on September 22, 2024. Ms. Antara Paul, a professional with over five years of experience in market research and sales optimization, led the initial class on "Effective Communication." She skillfully navigated the complexities of business communication, covering essential topics such as requests for information, SWOT analysis, and testimonial writing. Following her session, Ms. Deepika Chaudhary, a visual designer with more than a decade of experience, introduced the Canva tool and the basics of design, including principles for creating effective testimonials. Ms. Chaudhary outlined the upcoming classes, which would delve deeper into Canva, including an introduction to the tool, basic design principles, video editing, and ultimately, preparing a presentation for MILVEST.

The Digital Designing segment concluded with an assignment—Tasking 1. The latter part of the session featured Capt (IN) Vinay Singh (Retd.), who guided the class in creating and updating LinkedIn accounts. The day wrapped up with an assignment to create and upload a testimonial on individual LinkedIn profiles.



The second session was equally stimulating, focusing on testimonial design. Ms. Greeshma Kadangot shared key aspects of designing professional-level testimonials, analyzing submissions with live examples. Ms. Deepika Chaudhary then returned to provide in-depth instruction on Canva, covering every detail. The day continued with a session on "Presence on LinkedIn," led by Wing Commander Stefi Bathla. She emphasized the importance of maintaining an active presence on LinkedIn for networking and seizing opportunities. Participants were assigned to create two testimonials on the themes "My Journey as a MILVETian" and "My Memorable Day at #ME\_MILVEST," which were to be created using Canva tool and further uploaded to their LinkedIn profiles.

On the third Sunday, coinciding with the auspicious Navratri festival, the Digital Designing segment resumed with a thorough analysis of selected submissions. Ms. Greeshma Kadangot provided practical lessons based on these analyses. Ms. Deepika Chaudhary then led an extended session on the Canva tool, diving deep into design principles of Contrast, Repetition, Alignment, and Proximity (CRAP). Due to the depth of this session, the LinkedIn Essentials segment was not covered that day, but it concluded with a challenging assignment illustrated by sample videos from volunteer SOMs.



The Digital Designing Course provided participants with a valuable realization: that design is a powerful tool for enhancing communication across industries. Whether in project proposals, strategic planning, or marketing, strong visual content can elevate how messages are conveyed. Participants are doing the course with the confidence and ability to create high-quality, professional designs, understanding how visual communication plays a vital role in business.

Participants explored core concepts like layout design, colour theory, typography, and branding. This foundation empowered them to create visuals that are not only attractive but also aligned with a company's identity, a crucial skill in today's visually-driven business landscape. Effective communication through design was a major focus of the course, with an emphasis on using simplicity and clarity to make complex ideas more accessible.

Participants learned how to combine creativity with functionality, ensuring their designs conveyed meaningful messages while remaining aesthetically pleasing. The course also provided insight into how impactful first impressions can be, whether it's through testimonials, banners, posts, business reports, or branding efforts.

Through this platform, I discovered the Lean Six Sigma Green Belt course, conducted by MILVEST - Sambhav Kadam Foundation in collaboration with Grant Thornton Bharat LLP, from March 25 to 31, 2024. Additionally, we gained hands-on experience with Minitab software, allowing us to analyze different types of sample data, understand data types, and interpret them using suitable statistical tools. Mr. Rach's real-world examples and engaging teaching style made the learning experience not only educational but also deeply practical.

Achieving the Lean Six Sigma Green Belt certification has been a significant milestone for me. It has not only enhanced my ability to identify and solve operational challenges but also empowered me to bring structured problem-solving approaches into every aspect of my professional life. The confidence and skills I gained through this course have undoubtedly positioned me to create more impactful changes within my field. Moreover, this experience has motivated me to pursue a Black Belt certification in the future, as I aim to deepen my expertise and contribute even more significantly to my industry.


#### LEAN SIX SIGMA BLACK BELT

- Market Opportunity Investors care about the potential size of the market. We explored how to present
  market research convincingly, demonstrating the scalability of the business model and the urgency of
  the solution in meeting real-world needs.
- Business Model and Revenue Projections -Financial viability is a key focus for investors. We learned how to present the business model, revenue streams, and profitability potential through clear and concise financial projections.
- The Team Investors often invest in people, not just ideas. We learned the importance of highlighting the strengths and expertise of the team and how their complementary skills drive the startup's potential for success.



## The Importance of Delivery

Beyond creating a well-structured pitch deck, delivery is equally important. Dr. Prakash emphasized the power of storytelling—how connecting emotionally with the audience, using persuasive language, and delivering the pitch with confidence can leave a lasting impact. We also received practical tips on handling tough questions from investors and maintaining composure under pressure.

By the end of the course, I had not only learned how to create a professional pitch deck but also had the opportunity to present it and receive valuable feedback. This hands-on experience reinforced the importance of preparation, confidence, and clear communication when pitching a business idea.

## Literary Challenge: Nurturing Creativity and Expression



## SOM'S BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION A Memorable Event







- Unknown Area: Unknown to both



The exercise helps participants uncover strengths, identify growth areas, and enhance team communication. One participant shared, "I realized qualities I saw as weaknesses were viewed as strengths by others, reshaping my self-perception."

Overall, the activity fostered trust, open communication, and constructive feedback within teams.







# ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE MEETS PRACTICAL RELEVANCE


